- Carrier's Liability and Valuation
- Use IATA's The Air Cargo Tariff and Rules (TACT) manual for specific country and Carrier regulations
- Basic Rating (GCR, SCR, CR, ULD, Construction, Combination)
- Apply correct cargo acceptance procedures
- Cargo Documentation
- Understand the conditions of carriage
- Complete an Air Waybill, the official contract of carriage Special cargo
- Aircraft structure, layout, limitation, and Unit Load Device (ULD)

Assessment:

A written examination will be held at the end of the course in order to test participant's comprehension of air cargo skills and procedures knowledge.
